## To Qualify to Become A Volunteer We Require:

- All applicants to complete an application.
- All applicants to be at least 16 years of age.
- All applicants (under the age of 18) to submit two personal references.
- All applicants to show proof of a recent tuberculosis screening (no more than 6 months old).
- All applicants to complete a government required background screening. The cost is \$50 for DC and Maryland residents and \$65 for Virginia residents. The cost for others states will vary. Your screening will be conducted at the following location:
